



## BACKGROUND

The Ministry of Energy and Mineral Development is implementing the Forest Management and Sustainable Charcoal Value chain project, which is supported by the Food and Agricultural Organization of the United Nations and the European Union. 6. Participating actively in planning and facilitating research and training for the charcoal association members to extract best practices in charcoal production and trade information that is relevant to association members.
7. Supporting planning and facilitating the Charcoal Association events & meetings.
8. Providing periodic reports on issues regarding sustainable charcoal value chain and propose relevant recommendations for the future development and long-term vision on the Charcoal Vendors Association.
9. Develop strategies to increase Marketing opportunities for sustainably produced charcoal;
10. Coordinates the marketing activities of all areas of the Charcoal Vendors Association involved in delivering services to the Membership and build partnerships to carry out collection, distribution, storage & transport;
